Smart Meter among highlights of EPRE 2015

KUALA LUMPUR: The Smart Meter will be one of the main highlights of the Electric, Power and Renewable Energy Malaysia 2015 (EPRE 2015) exhibition to be held from today to Friday at the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre.

Managing director of Fleming Gulf Silvester Pullman said a Smart Meter would be able to give accurate meter readings based on a household consumption while at the same time channel the electricity to where it is most used to enable efficient usage and avoid energy wastage.

"A total of 1,000 houses in Putrajaya and Malacca have been in-

stalled with Smart Meters in a pilot project and the results were successful.

"It has also become an effective tool that is able to reduce disputes between customers and suppliers on the high electricity consumption bills. We are expecting the host (Tenaga Nasional Bhd) to announce the results during the exhibition and also reveal the decision on whether the Smart Meters would be the way forward," he said.

The project, which was known as "Project Smartstyle", involved 800 homes in Malacca and 200 homes in Putrajaya, commenced last year.
